Please be prepared with a short memorized monologue of any kind, no more than 2 minutes in length. There will also be cold readings from the script in a group setting.

Please wear comfortable clothing and appropriate shoes and be ready for movement during auditions.

Please come prepared with a list of conflicts for every single date from November 20, 2023, through opening on February 9th, 2024. Rehearsal schedules will be determined after the show is cast, but will generally be at least 3 days a week including weekends.

Please understand that The Play That Goes Wrong is an extremely physical comedy and will require its cast to perform moderate to heavy lifting, pushing, pulling, physical stunts, crawling and jumping.

Character List:

This is a play within a play, so each actor playing a role within The Murder at Haversham Manor, has 2 character names.

Ages and genders can vary.

The Cornley Drama Society Stage Crew:

Varying genders and ages; will appear onstage and assist with stunts offstage as well.

Annie:

Company's Stage Manager. Functions as stage crew and replaces an actress onstage during the play.

Trevor:

Company's light and sound operator. Functions as Stage crew; interacts with the audience and is onstage for most of the play.

Chris:

Head of Cornley Drama Society; Director of the play; plays Inspector Carter.

Jonathan:

Plays Charles Haversham, the supposed victim.

Robert:

Plays Thomas Colley Moore, Charles' old school friend.

Dennis:

Plays Perkins, Charles' butler.

Max:

Plays Cecil Haversham, Charles' brother. Also Plays Arthur the Gardener. This role may be split by 2 actors.

Sandra:

Plays Florence Colley Moore, Charles' fiancée and Thomas' sister.
